Kelsick Educational Foundation

Trustees of the Kelsick Educational Foundation are simplifying the grants procedure, by creating three main categories within which individuals can apply. These are: Education, including core tuition; Performing Arts, including music, art, drama and dance tuition; and Sport and Youth Groups, including junior sports teams, toddler groups and youth organisations.

Individual applicants can apply for up to £200 in each of the 3 categories per annum. Additionally, educational grants can also include residentials, trips, work placements and electives, at 40% of the cost up to £400 maximum per individual, per year. Annual travel grants of £125 are awarded to students at 6th form college, Further Education college, apprenticeships or training placements. Grants can also be given towards essential equipment or clothing, maximum £500. Students in Higher Education can receive subsistence of £1,000 annually, or £500 if living at home. Exceptional grants not listed in specific categories are also considered, including special needs, hardship funding, and supporting excellence.

Grant applicants must have lived in LA22 for four or more years, and be under 25. Applications must be made within six months of any expense being incurred and receipts must be provided. Applications are considered by the Trustees quarterly in February, May, August and November and must be received by the 24th of the preceding month. Your guide to Autumn vaccinations

Autumn is vaccination season - a your protection against the bugs

and illnesses that circulate more readily during the colder months.

There are several seasonal vaccines available from October:

Flu Vaccine: The annual flu vaccine is available for those at higher risk, including individuals aged 65 and over, pregnant women, and people with chronic health conditions. This vaccine is updated each year to target the most common flu strains expected to circulate.

COVID-19 Booster: The COVID-19 booster vaccine is offered to adults aged over 65, frontline health and social care workers, and those with specific health conditions. It is designed to enhance protection against severe illness and is updated to address the latest variants.

All eligible patients will be invited by the GP surgery, and these vaccinations will also be available from some local pharmacies.

Other vaccinations are available year-round to provide you with protection.

You might also have heard about the new RSV (Respiratory **Syncytial Virus) vaccine.** RSV can cause severe respiratory illness in infants, older adults, and those with weakened immune systems. The vaccine is now available for adults between 75-79 and those who are 28 weeks pregnant from the GP surgery.

In addition, **Pneumococcal and Shingles vaccinations** are available for patients over 65 years old. Please contact the surgery to find out more, check your eligibility, and book your jabs now.


Thoughts over Brathay Bridge



I'm really worried that I won't be able to afford to keep warm this winter. I don't want to claim benefits, and I don't think I would get anything

anyway because I get a State Pension.

If you have reached pension age, and your income is below a minimum amount decided by the government, you are entitled to Pension Credit, and there is nothing to be embarrassed about in claiming what you qualify for. It's worth applying even if you don't think you'll get much, because if you receive Pension Credit, even a small amount, you'll be able to get the Winter Fuel Payment, and other financial help.

There are two parts to Pension Credit. Guarantee Credit tops up your weekly income to a minimum amount. Savings Credit is a small top-up for people who have a modest amount of income or savings. It's only available if you reached State Pension age before 6 April 2016. You might get one or both parts, depending on your circumstances.

Our pupils had exceeded national levels across all subjects, including Reading/Writing/Maths combined and it was wonderful to see all of the children's hard work and perseverance pay off. Our former year 6s were a super group of children and we're excited to hear about what they go on to achieve next.

As one cohort leaves, a new one joins the school and we welcomed a new group of children into our Reception class on the first day of term. They've done a brilliant job settling in to the many routines of school and an even better job at navigating the different parts of the school building. It's easy to forget that everything seems so much bigger when you're 4 years old!

In classes, we're currently diving in to Fairtrade Fortnight and are teaching the children all about the Fairtrade movement and the work that it does to support farmers in 68 different countries across the world. The project is also giving the children the opportunity to learn about the different places that their food products come from and to find local shops that cater for the conscious consumer.
