In addition to these special services, we've also introduced changes to our regular Sunday worship to provide more opportunities for all ages to engage with faith in a way that feels meaningful and authentic.


9:15 am Reflective Service

School News - Ambleside CE Primary School



Earlier in the autumn term, our year 6 children successfully completed their Bikeability training. It's great to see so many of our children choosing to ride their bikes to school so supporting them in learning how to ride on the roads safely is really important for them. We're keen to promote the benefits of bike riding with our younger children too and invited Pro Ride Coaching into school to work with them on our balance bikes. In their sessions, they learnt all about bike safety and enjoyed using the balance bikes to navigate obstacles and challenges.



Our year 5 and 6 children were invited to Ambleside Parish Centre to join Gale for 'Stories Together'. They met with Francis and Kenza who shared a story called 'Stepping Stones – A Refugee's Family's Journey' and read the story in both English and Arabic. The story was about a young girl who had to flee her hometown due to war with

pictures in the book inspired by the stone artwork of Syrian artist Nizar Ali Badr. Afterwards, the children enjoyed having the opportunity to create their own artwork based on something that they would miss if they had to leave their home. Before half-term, we held our annual Harvest Service in St Mary's Church, Ambleside and were joined by lots of friends and family. In the run -up to Harvest, we looked at the Christian values of generosity and thankfulness together. We thought about how, even the smallest gift



can make a really positive impact on someone else. At Harvest, we reflected on the many things that we are grateful and thankful for in our lives (including our abundance of food) and our families generously brought along donations of food which were given to Ambleside Parish Centre's Community Food Cupboard.

We now turn our attention to the lead up to Christmas with lots of

Bellringing in Ambleside

Here at St Mary's we are fortunate to have a magnificent ring of eight bells, cast in 1901 by Taylor's Bell Foundry of Loughborough.

The bells form an octave tuned to D flat and the heaviest, known as the tenor, is an impressive 32½ hundred weight; that's 1651kgs, or over 1.6 tons. According to R. H. Dove's *Guide to the Church Bells of Britain*, ours is the fifth heaviest ring of eight in the British Isles, with only Adelaide Cathedral out-weighing us in the rest of the world.

There is regular ringing before the 11 a.m. Sunday service, when the small local band is often augmented by visitors from other towers around the country. With the help of other local bands, we also hold occasional practice nights on Monday evenings.



Tackling your finances - small changes with big effects

Sometimes tackling your finances can
