Thurman's work as a civil rights leader led him to bring a such a spirit to the darkness of the world, a world that needed God's peace on all 365 days of the year, and still does.


Here's the poem -

Although January was quiet in Ambleside, it was action from day one when we reopened after the Christmas break!

# Ambleside Action for a Future: Community Garden

An exciting new Community Garden for Ambleside is coming into being at Rydal Hall. The land was once a community garden but has not been kept up for about a decade. Now, with the dire effects of climate change on our horizon, resilience, adaptation and food security are becoming a priority. Gardening to help threatened bees and other pollinators is also an urgent need.

The garden has already got a number of raised beds and an orchard – in urgent need of pruning. It is in a quiet and lovely area above Rydal Hall on a south facing sunny slope. The garden will be organic and will be cultivated using the no-dig principle. Some work has begun already but will start in earnest as spring comes. It's envisaged that some produce will go to members of the Community Garden group with any excess going to groups that provide food for people in particular need in our community.
